- Faculty Updates/Announcements
  - Welcome to new undergraduate faculty liaison for this quarter!
  - o Reminder of COVID-19 protocols
  - Student tested positive on January 4<sup>th</sup>. So far no other known positive cases in the department/building. Student is recovering well.
- Approval of Meeting Minutes
  - o Approval of minutes from 12/03 faculty meeting
  - o Motion to approve and seconded by faculty members.
  - o 6 yes, 0 no, 0 abstain
- Chair's Report
  - COVID update Projections from IHME: likely will see a difficult month to six weeks due to holiday/travel. WA State is doing much better than other places (like Los Angeles). Predicted slow-down in April and a slow summer.
    - Spring quarter may have more in-person activity, but classes will mostly look like Winter quarter in terms of online vs. in-person.
  - OPlan is to be largely in-person for Autumn quarter, depending on efficacy and distribution of vaccine. Might not be able to have large lecture courses meet inperson with all students present at once; may have to take a hybrid approach.
  - Not known yet if UW professors will be in the same category for vaccination as K-12 teachers.
  - A&S Dean's search update: Search timeline pushed back. Airport interviews in March. Finalists to visit campus in May/early June, with final selection in mid-June. Bob Stacey will stay until September 1<sup>st</sup> to help with transition
  - o UW in good shape financially, but we may not be able to have merit increases.
    - Unable to increase tuition or get more money from the state while costs increase.
    - Minimized need for furloughs or layoffs.
  - Reminders:
